Daniel was assigned to the 46<sup>th</sup> Alabama Infantry Regiment of the CSA, which was organized in May 1862. The unit was originally sent to East Tennessee where it sustained several casualties in the fight at Tazewell. After the Kentucky Campaign the unit was assigned to General Tracey's Brigade of Mississippi and East Louisiana. They saw action at Port Gibson, Champion's Hill, Vicksburg, Chattanooga, Atlanta and Bentonville. Of the 367 men in January 1864 only 75 was left standing to surrender in April 1865.
