

Elizabeth Jones was born in 1840 and was the second born child to Seaborn and Mary "Adams" Jones. Seaborn was responsible for introducing this Jones line to Jackson County, Florida (circa) 1845. When Elizabeth married William David Huff in 1869 it was his second marriage. He brought two sons into the marriage. She raised William and James as her own. Elizabeth and William David had Thomas, Havilla and the last born was Henry. Henry was born in May 1874 and married his first cousin Retta Jones on February 6th 1910 in Jackson County. Retta was the daughter of Thomas Jones and Eliza "Baxter" Jones.

Elizabeth was 18 years younger than William David Huff and outlived him by 41 years. For some reason when she expired in 1922 (her headstone is marked in error) she was buried at Friendship Cemetery a mile west of Collins. Research does not indicate she was married after William David.
